Key Dates:

Oct. 30 – Registrations will be accepted at the Ski Swap

Nov. 19 – **Early Registration deadline** – after this date, fees increase by \$50 per athlete*
At least 50% of fees must be paid by Nov. 19 to qualify for early registration rates.

Dec. 1 – **Final Registration deadline** – after this date, athletes will not be able to join programs until coaching/group assignments can be worked out

Dec. 1 – Latest date that cheques for balance of fees may be post-dated.

* This surcharge on late registrations is applied because late registrants may miss participating in important fall fundraising events, such as Rossland Film Fest and the Ski Swap. Also, late registration creates difficulties in hiring and scheduling of qualified coaches.

1. Nancy Greene - ages 6-12* (also called "Entry Level")

- 6-8 years old category - Entry Level 1 or "E1"
- 9-12 years old category - Entry Level 2 or "E2"

2. Kinder - ages 11-14 (Kinder - German for "Children")

- 11-12 year old category - Kinder 1 or "K1"
- 13-14 year old category - Kinder 2 or "K2"

3. FIS - ages 15 and older (FIS - French for "International Ski Federation")

- 15-16 year old category – Junior 1 or "J1"
- 17-19 year old category – Junior 2 or "J2"

IN CONSIDERATION OF ALPINE CANADA ALPIN (A.C.A.) AND THE CANADIAN SKI ASSOCIATION (THE C.S.A.) ACCEPTING MY APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AND PERMITTING ME TO PARTICIPATE IN COMPETITIONS, EVENTS OR TRAINING AUTHORIZED OR SANCTIONED BY A.C.A. (HEREAFTER REFERED TO AS "THE COMPETITOR") AND PERMITTING THE COMPETITOR TO PARTICIPATE TO COMPETITONS, EVENTS OR TRAINING AUTHORIZED OR SANCTIONED BY A.C.A. AND THE C.S.A.. I HEREBY FOR MYSELF, MY HEIRS, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS AND ASSIGNS AS FOLLOWS:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS THAT I MAY HAVE AGAINST A.C.A., THE C. S. A., THE SKI CLUB, ZONE OR DIVISION NAMED IN SECTION A ABOVE, ANY OTHER SKI CLUB OR SKI AREA CONNECTED WITH SUCH COMPETITIONS, EVENTS, TRAINING AND THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, OFFICIALS, AGENTS, VOLUNTEERS AND SPONSORS (ALL OF WHOM ARE HERINAFTER COLLECTIVELY REFERED TO AS THE RELEASEES.)
2. TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE INJURY OR EXPENSE THAT I MAY SUFFER OR THAT MY NEXT-OF-KIN MAY SUFFER AS A RESULT OF MY OR THE COMPETITOR'S PARTICIPATION IN THE SAID COMPETITIONS, EVENTS TRAINING DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER INCLUDING ANY NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES.
3. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY THE RELEASEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR ANY PROPERTY, DAMAGE, PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH SUSTAINED BY THE COMPETITOR OR BY ANY THIRD PART RESULTING FROM THE COMPETITOR'S PARTICIPATION IN THE SAID COMPETITIONS, EVENTS OR TRAINING.



CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Athletes are expected to always:

- act in a way that shows pride in being a member of the Red Mountain Racers, one of the oldest and most successful ski racing organizations in Canada
- strive to achieve and show the highest levels of good sportsmanship and team spirit
- act in a respectful and helpful manner towards all of their fellow members, the coaching staff, fellow athletes and their parents, without whose many hours of volunteer work, the club's programs would not exist
- act in a courteous and helpful way towards the general public, the skiing public and ski industry employees and ensure that their appearance and language reflect this attitude
- act in a friendly and helpful way towards fellow racers (and help the younger and/or less experienced racers to feel part of the team)
- show respect and cooperation to coaching staff. The racer must be committed to attend races and training sessions (snow & dryland) on time and prepared. If unable to do so, they must notify their coach as much ahead of time as possible.

Unacceptable athlete behavior includes, but is not limited to:

- repeated failure to participate in the program as designed for the athlete
- blatant disrespect for people and property (athletes, coaches, officials, sponsors, equipment, ski areas, etc.)
- blatant use of foul language
- bullying, horseplay on lifts, line crashing
- stealing
- using alcohol or tobacco products of any kind
- using, encouraging the use of, or distributing drugs
- sexual activity with other athletes

General common sense will be a guide in identifying other unacceptable behaviours.

Disciplinary Action:

Athletes who engage in unacceptable behavior may be subject to disciplinary action by the coaches and/or the club Executive. Decisions on short-term disciplinary actions may be made by coaches, in consultation with the Head Coach and/or Alpine Chair, when feasible. All coaches have the authority to decide on appropriate short-term disciplinary action in cases where it is not possible to consult with others in a timely manner.

Major infraction:

- has serious impact on the athlete, other athletes or individuals and the program as a whole (e.g. sexual activity with team mates, use of drugs)
- may result in suspension or expulsion from program

Minor infraction:

- has limited impact on athlete, other athletes or individuals or program as whole (e.g. use of foul language, failure to participate in designed program, bullying)
- may result in short-term disciplinary action (e.g. withdrawal of training or racing privileges for one to six days, depending on frequency of occurrence.)

Athletes' parents will be informed of all infractions and disciplinary actions. There will be no refunds of program fees for time missed resulting from a disciplinary action of any kind.

Any decision regarding long-term or permanent disciplinary action (suspension for one or more weeks, or expulsion from membership) will be made only by a panel of three independent RMR Executive members who have no links to the incident(s) under investigation. On expulsion from membership, any outstanding balance in the athlete's expense account with the club is payable within 30 days.

Appeals:

- No appeal process for any short-term disciplinary actions.
- For major infractions resulting in expulsion, appeal may be made to a panel to be composed of two independent RMR Executive members (who were not part of the discipline panel) and one individual not connected with RMR and mutually agreed upon by the RMR President and the appellant.

Parents are expected to:

- Refrain from interfering with the coaching staff in their efforts to teach and encourage the athletes.
- Participate willingly in fundraising activities, races and other events associated with the club.

POLICY: Financial – Athlete Expense Policy

POLICY SECTION: 6.1.1 Financial – Racer Accounts

DESCRIPTION:

This policy is intended to ensure that athlete accounts for program fees and race expenses are paid in a timely manner so that the club does not experience cash flow problems.

Athletes attending camps or FIS races will be required to pay the estimated cost of the trip prior to departing with the team. Athletes attending K level races will be required to pay expense account invoices within 15 days, or no further costs will be incurred by the club for those athletes.

Interest of 2% per month will be charged on account balances that are over 30 days outstanding.

Travel and lodging costs for camps and FIS races will be divided equally among the athletes who attend. In the event of cancellation of a trip by an athlete, the athlete must still pay 100% of their cost share of the travel and lodging, if the cancellation by the athlete occurs too late to obtain a refund, or to change the bookings. The cancellation charge will be waived only in the event of athlete injury/illness or *bona fide* family emergency.

Coaches' travel expenses for camps, FIS races and K races will be divided evenly and charged to the athletes participating in each event. (RMR coaches make every effort to keep lodging and other costs to an absolute minimum, the club specifies modest mileage rates and per diem meal rates for coaches.)
